

FISHGUARD – LOCAL NOTICE TO MARINERS 01/2022

Recovery of Capsized Pontoon

Issued 23rd February, 2022
Expires Valid until withdrawn on completion of operations

A small jack-up pontoon has capsized and sunk in the approximate location indicated on the attached chart. Note that the legs of the pontoon extend away from the quay wall approximately 40 metres.

The pontoon is visible at all states of the tide and is partially illuminated at night by the Port's floodlights. Additional lights or buoys may be placed on or around the pontoon.

Salvage operations will commence in February and mariners are advised that workboats, cranes and diving operations will be encountered in the areas adjacent to the pontoon.

Harbour users are requested to give the area a wide berth and pass at slow speed until operations are completed.
